

## The Modern Slavery Act 2015 (Act) Modern Slavery & Human Trafficking Statement

Koito Europe Limited (KEL) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Koito Manufacturing Co Limited a Japanese based global manufacturer of automotive lighting products.

This statement relates to actions and activities during the financial year 1 January 2016 to 31 December 2016.

The Act requires KEL to disclose the steps it has taken to ensure that slavery and human trafficking are not taking place in its business or in its supply chain.

During the relevant financial year KEL has taken the following steps. KEL has:

- 1 established a modern slavery working group to develop our work on modern slavery;
- 2 started work on developing a comprehensive Modern Slavery Policy;
- 3 started developing training for its employees who have direct responsibility for supply chain management;
- 4 commenced work on a procurement policy which will require KEL suppliers to confirm that they do not engage in modern slavery in their own operation and that such practices are not part of their supply chain;
- 5 started developing a supplier self-assessment questionnaire.

The KEL board recognise the importance of the provisions of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and the directors aim to ensure that slavery and human trafficking have no part in KEL's operation or its supply chain.
