MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT

This statement is made on behalf of MTI Technology Limited pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act (the "Act") and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement.

MTI Technology Limited is a limited liability company registered in Scotland (registered number SC112019) and is part of the MTI Europe Group, which is made up of separately constituted legal entities in the Netherlands, France and Germany.

We are currently reviewing our procurement process and will be introducing specific measures to ensure that our obligations under the Act are imposed throughout our supply chain, including incorporating a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier. The level of management control required for these supply sources will be continually monitored.

Our senior management team shall take responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resources (training etc.) and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within its organisation or within its supply chains.

This policy statement will be reviewed annually and published on MTIs website & shared with all MTI employees via NETconsent.
